LEAD Mentor for the Art of Nature: Application Deadline April 28nd

The San Angelo Museum of Fine Arts is seeking a responsible, physically active Art, Kinesiology, Science or Education major to work as Lead Mentor for Art of Nature camp in San Angelo from June 5th – June 30th. The Lead Mentor will need to be available for Art of Nature Camp Training and Scheduling from May 16nd – June 2nd, specific times and dates TBD. Lead Mentor will report directly to the Curator of Education or the Studio Educator. Pay is \$14 an hour.

Responsibilities include:

- Supervise Camp Mentors, ensuring that they follow camp and museum policies
- Act as a liaison between parents, Camp Mentors, and the Curator of Education to address children's and mentor's needs
- Supervise campers, ensuring safety and encouraging participation and engagement in camp activities
- Manage medical and emergency information of campers, ensuring that all special needs of campers are met
- Serve as positive role models for campers (ages 7-12), ensure camper safety and encourage participation and engagement in camp activities
- Implement camp curriculum (art and science activities) and other activities for campers, and keep camp on schedule
- Be aware of medical and emergency information for campers to ensure their safety

The ideal candidate should possess the following characteristics:

- Proven experience working with children
- The ability to remain positive and collected under stressful situations
- Physically active, enjoys outdoor activities and is able to walk and hike at least 1/2 mile
- An interest in art, science, museums and/or nature
- A creative problem solver and self-motivator
- Dependable, organized and friendly
- Open to trying and learning new things
- Team player, works extremely well with others

This position is full-time/temporary, averaging no more than 30-40 hours per week from May 16th – June 30th. Chosen candidates MUST be available to work the entire month of June.
