A dynamic husband-wife artistic team, Colin and Kristine Poole are known for their classically inspired contemporary realism.

While they both maintain individual bodies of work, their collaborative sculptures have featured prominently in publications including The Wall Street Journal, ARC International Salon, Ceramics Monthly and Ceramics Ireland, among others. Winners of the 2023 IBA Grand Prize and Beautiful Bizarre Magazine's 2020 International Art Prize Sculpture Category, they have been commissioned to create works for National Geographic, National Audubon, Spectrum, Denver Comic Con, Daimler-Benz, Lourdes Cathedral - France as well as numerous Fortune 500 companies. Their work spans small to life-size as well as monumental bronze public art works, most recently for the Carnegie Library in Michigan and the city of Arlington, VA. They currently live and create in the foothills of the Sangre de Cristo mountains overlooking Santa Fe, inspired by their menagerie of birds and beasts
